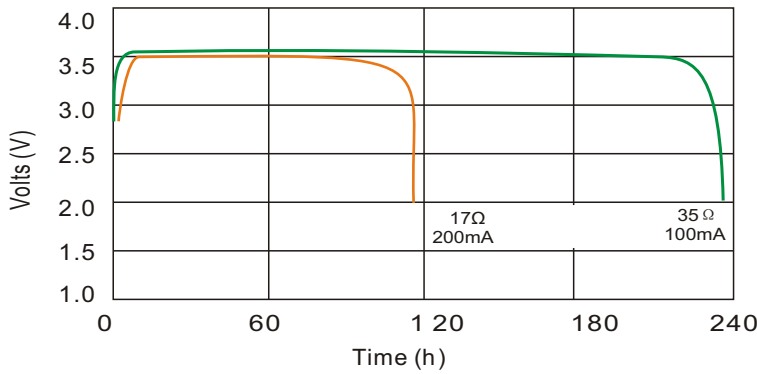

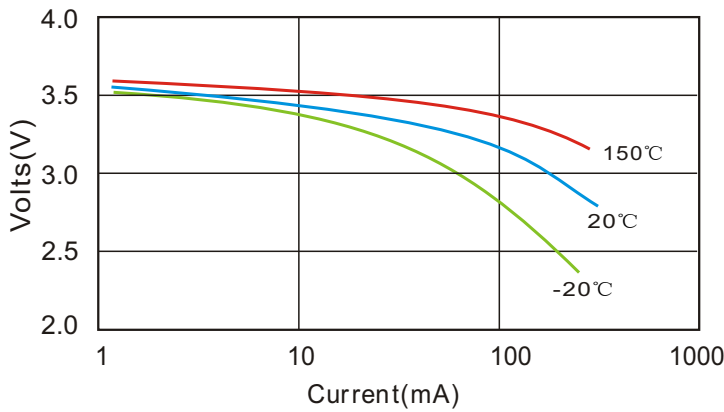

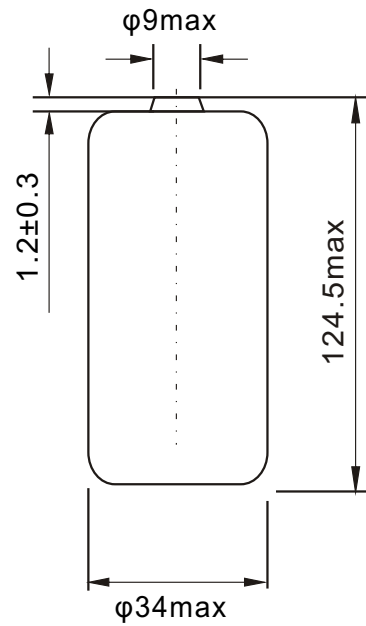
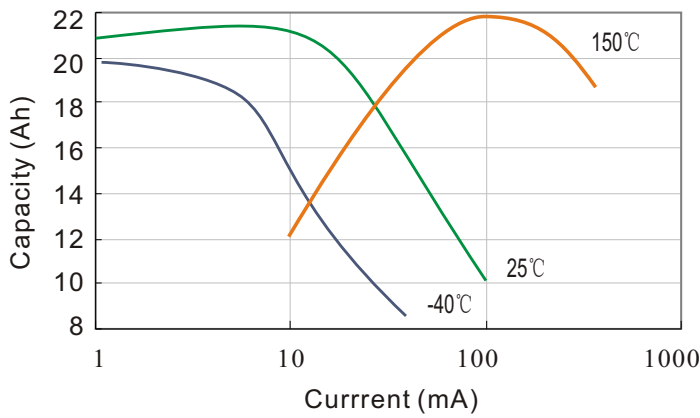
Typical discharge at 150°C
